**Subject: Violation of BPPRA Rules 2014, Project Director, Gwadar Lasbela Livelihoods Support Project- Phase-II (GLLSP- II), Quetta's Tender Notice for Construction of Roads.**

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to your tender notice appeared in daily 'Jang' newspaper on 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 2023. The said advertisement is in violation of The Balochistan Public Procurement Rules, 2014, Rule 40 (Announcement of Evaluation Reports).

As per tender, it is stated that; "IFAD Project GLLSP- II reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids without assigning any reason."

However, according to BPPRA Rules 2014, Rule 40, Procuring Agencies shall announce reasons for non-acceptance of all other bids or rejection of each bid at least [three (3) working days] prior to the award of procurement contract. Hence, it is a violation BPPRA Rules 2014, Rule No 40.

The Rule is quoted below for your reference;

*40. Announcement of evaluation reports. (1) Procuring Agencies shall announce and upload on Authority's web the results of bid evaluation in the form of a report giving justification for acceptance of lowest evaluated bid, and reasons for non-acceptance of all other bids or rejection of each bid at least [three (3) working days] prior to the award of procurement contract.*

*Provided that a copy of the evaluation report shall be provided to any bidder who may request for the same.*

Chief Secretary, Balochistan is requested to issue directives to the Project Director, GLLSP- II to rectify the given mistake and issue corrigendum in accordance with BPPRA Rules 2014 to avoid mis-procurement under Rule 57.
