Sub: Complaint on the Allegations of Violation of SPPRA Rules 2010 by Executive Engineer, Highway Division Thatta, Sindh in Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) TC/G-55/285 Dated 14/04/2023 for Procurement of different ADP Works.

Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan has received a complaint on the allegations of Violation of Sindh Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (SPPRA Rules 2010) by Executive Engineer, Highway Division Thatta, Sindh in Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) TC/G-55/285 Dated 14/04/2023 for Procurement of different ADP works.

The complainant has made the following allegations that;

1. The Office of the Executive Engineer, Highway Division Thatta invited Notice Inviting Tender TC/G-55/285 dated 14/04/2023 for the procurement of different ADP works with a deadline of 8th May 2023.
2. The invitation to tender consists of various works in total 53. The Executive Engineer, Highway Division, Thatta has grouped several works into one large project with malafide intention of awarding it to a pre-identified firm, in violation of SPPRA Rules 2010 **(Annex-A)**.
3. In NIT, different work schemes (Serial No. 17, 20, 45, 13, 03, 47, 51, 52, 53 etc) situated at different locations are grouped together to show as one project so a single work order can be issued.
4. The procuring agency requires procurement of works in different villages but it has packaged/Regrouped the same with the intention to shorten the bidding competition, in violation of SPPRA Rules 2010.
5. SPPRA Rules 2010, Rule 12 and 13 clearly require that the procuring agency shall not package procurement plan and regroup the proposed procurement.

Transparency International Pakistan Comments

Transparency International Pakistan has reviewed the allegations of the complainant, prima facie the regrouping tantamount to restrict the wider competition and transparency. Following are TI Pakistan comments;

1. SPPRA Rule 12 requires that the procuring agencies shall not package procurement plan and regroup the proposed procurements. Rule 12 is quoted below;



SPPRA Rule 12: Limitation on Splitting or Regrouping of Proposed Procurement.- The procuring agency shall not split or package a procurement plan with the intention to shorten or facilitate the procurement process and approval mechanism, unless the procuring agency is satisfied that-

- a. Block acquisition of goods, services or works will unnecessarily hold up available resources.
- b. Technical reasons indicate that splitting or packaging will improve the quality.
- c. The impact of weather, geographical spread on certain procurement particularly in case of works contract will affect its execution with regard to quality and delivery schedule.

Provided that any splitting or packaging shall be made part of the revised procurement plan and uploaded on the Authority's website as well as on the website of the procuring agency, if functional.

2. The subject prequalification will shorten the bidding Competition which is a clear violation of SPPRA Rule 13, quoted below;

SPPRA Rule 13: Specifications (1) Specifications shall allow the widest possible competition and shall not favour any single contractor or supplier nor put others at a disadvantage. Specifications shall be generic and shall not include references to brand names, model numbers, catalogue numbers or similar classifications. However, if the procuring agency is convinced that the use of a reference to a brand name or a catalogue number is essential to complete an otherwise incomplete specification, such use or reference shall be qualified with the words "or equivalent".

(2) Procurement of used or reconditioned equipment, plant or machinery is not permissible in any case whatsoever.

3. Grouping of several works in different locations of Sindh imposes discriminatory and difficult conditions which results in unfair bidding, in violation of SPPRA Rule 44, quoted below;

SPPRA Rule 44: Discriminatory and difficult conditions.-

"Save as otherwise provided, no procuring agency shall introduce any condition which discriminates among bidders. In ascertaining the discriminatory nature of any condition reference shall be made to the ordinary practices of that trade, manufacturing, construction business or service to which that particular procurement is related".

Transparency International Pakistan Recommendations

Transparency International Pakistan requests Chief Minister Sindh to examine the complaint in light of SPPRA Rules 2010 and if found correct, direct the office of the executive engineer division thatta to rectify the above mentioned infirmities and re-initiate the procurement process in accordance with SPPRA Rules 2010 to avoid mis-procurement under SPPRA Rules 2010, Rule 56.

This is to clarify that Transparency International Pakistan is not a complainant, it acts as a whistleblower and operate under Article 19-A, of the Constitution of Pakistan which gives the right to public to know how government is being run by public officers. Article 19-A makes the right to access of information pertaining to a public authority a fundamental right, Justice Syed Mansoor Ali Shah in his landmark judgment in case of Ataulah Malik v. Federation of Pakistan includes following order.

Right to information is another corrective tool which allows public access to the working and decision making of the public authorities. It opens the working of public administration to public scrutiny. This necessitates transparent and structured exercise of discretion by the public functionaries. Article 19-A empowers the civil society of this country to seek information from public institutions and hold them answerable. PLD 2010 Lahore 605.

- ورک سیریل نمبر (6)&(10) ایک ہی جگہ پر واقع ہیں ایک ہی اسکیم ہے اس ایک اسکیم کو توڑ کر 12 سیکموں میں سیٹ کیا گیا ہے الگ سیریل نمبر دینے گئے ہیں تاکہ C6 کیٹیگری سے کمائی آگے نہ جائے۔
- ورک سیریل نمبر (36)&(42) ایک ہی جگہ پر واقع ہیں ایک ہی اسکیم ہے اس ایک اسکیم کو توڑ کر 12 سیکموں میں سیٹ کیا گیا ہے الگ سیریل نمبر دینے گئے ہیں تاکہ C6 کیٹیگری سے کمائی آگے نہ جائے۔
- ورک سیریل نمبر (31)&(40) ایک ہی جگہ پر واقع ہیں ایک ہی اسکیم ہے اس ایک اسکیم کو توڑ کر 12 سیکموں میں سیٹ کیا گیا ہے الگ سیریل نمبر دینے گئے ہیں۔ اس سے پہلے جی ایجوکیشن ورکس ٹھٹھہ میں ایسے غلط ٹینڈر جاری کیے گئے تھے جسے پیریم کورٹ آف پاکستان اور سپر ایڈپارٹمنٹ نے غیر قانونی عمل قرار دیا تھا جس لیٹر کی کاپی اور موجودہ این ای ٹی کی کاپی اس درخواست کے ساتھ شامل عرض ہے۔

آخر میں میری اعلیٰ احکام سے گزارش ہے کہ یہ ٹینڈر نوٹس بدینتی شفافیت سپر اردو کی خلاف ورزی پر مبنی ہے جسے منسوخ کیا جانے اور سپر اردو کے تحت دوبارہ ٹینڈر نوٹس کال کروا کر اسکیموں کی کروپنگ وغیرہ ختم کی جانے تاکہ عمارے ساتھ سب لوگوں کو روزگار کا موقع فراہم ہو سکے۔

SUBJECT: ISSUANCE OF NOTICE INVITING TENDERS WITHOUT MENTIONING THE CLEAR SCOPE OF WORK / NAME OF SCHOOL AND GROUPING OF SEVERAL SCHOOLS

It is informed that in terms of Rule-17(3)(b) of Sindh Public Procurement Rules, 2010 (Amended 2018), it is mandatory to provide the purpose and scope of the project in the Notice Inviting Tenders. It has, however, been observed that most of the Executive Engineers, Education Works Divisions have started to invite tenders by just mentioning the package numbers with number of units and PEC Category. It has also been observed that procuring agencies have grouped several schools having different locations to form a large scheme without mentioning the name and locations of schools and estimated costs of each work/ school. This tantamount to restricting wider competition and transparency. The procuring agencies have been informed regarding the infirmities a number of times, but no action has yet been taken by procuring agencies for rectification of the infirmities.

2. It is relevant to mention that this Authority has also received a complaint from former Judge of Supreme Court and member Transparency International Pakistan pointing out the same infirmities, which was forwarded to the concerned procuring agency for comments. The response of the procuring agency to the complaint is not in line with Rule-17(3)(c) of Sindh Public Procurement Rules, 2010 (Amended 2018).

3. In view of the above, the procuring agencies are advised to take appropriate action as per rules for rectifying the above mentioned infirmities and re-initiate the procurement process in line with SPP Rules and after fulfilling all codal formalities. It may be noted that bid evaluation reports of all such NITs having above mentioned infirmities shall not be hosted on SPPRA website.
