Sub: Amendment In SPPRA Regulations for Works Issued on 10.04.23.

Dear Sir,

The SPPRA Board in its 30th Meeting dated 10.04.23 has approved the amendment in SPPRA Regulations for procurement of Works, in two categories, Experience in similar nature of work(s) executed during the last five years., and the Average Annual Financial Turn-over during last five years, by reducing theses requirements to 80% and cost of project respectively. Annex-A.

The amended requirements of revised experience and past performance are quoted below;

Regulation Clause 2.16 - Experience and Past Performance:

7.9 (i) Experience in similar nature of work(s) executed during the last five years;

- i. At least on similar nature of work having minimum cost 80% of the estimated cost of the work; or**
- ii. At least two similar nature works each having minimum cost 50% of the estimated cost.**

Regulation Clause 2.16 - Financial

7.9 (i) Average Annual Financial Turn-over not less than equivalent cost of the scheme/ project during last five years.

It is noted that in the past, the discriminatory practices such as requiring Experience in similar nature of work(s) executed during the last five years more than twice the cost of project, and annual financial turnover sometimes was more than twice the project cost were widely used in the procurement process to restrict open competition and fair play.

TI Pakistan request the Chief Secretary, Sindh to issue directives to all the Secretaries to follow Regulation Clause 2.16, 7.9 (i)(ii)(iii) Experience and Past Performance and 2.16 7.9 (i) Financial,



SPPRA Regulations for Works dated 10.04.23. In all ongoing procurements, where **Clause 2.16 - Experience and Past Performance** is used, addendum shall be issued about the amended limits, and amended limits shall be used in all future procurement.

The Secretaries may issue directives to respective departments under their authority to ensure compliance and the dates may be extended for all the ongoing tenders by at least 1 week so that the new regulations may be complied with.

Regulation Clause #	Amendment
2.16	Experience and past performance:
7.9(i)	Experience in similar nature of work(s) executed during the last five years: i. At least one similar nature of work having minimum cost 80% of the estimated cost of the work; or ii. At least two similar nature works each having minimum cost 50% of the estimated cost.
2.16	Financial –
7.9(i)	Average Annual Financial Turn-over not less than equivalent cost of the scheme/project during last five years.

2. This shall come into force with immediate effect.
