**Subject: NOMINATION OF CSO REPRESENTATIVES FOR THE WORKSHOP ON COUNTERING VIOLENT EXTREMISM THROUGH COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT 23-24 APRIL 2024 AT ISLAMABAD**

National Counter Terrorism Authority (NACTA), in collaboration with the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), is organizing a workshop titled "Countering Violent Extremism Through Community Engagement," scheduled for 23-24 April 2024 in Islamabad. This initiative is part of the ongoing efforts under the Country Programme 2022-2025, particularly Sub-Programme IV: Preventing & Countering Terrorism of UNODC, aimed at fostering effective responses to terrorism-related crimes and enhancing community engagement.

2. The workshop intends to gather various stakeholders, including government officials, CSOs, and experts, to deliberate and strategize on countering violent extremism through community engagement. Topics of discussion will include network objectives, national policy presentation, international best practices, and an introduction to expert networks supporting policy, victim assistance, communication narratives, and youth empowerment.

3. UNODC will cover the cost of travel, accommodation, and logistics for one representative from each nominated CSO based outside Islamabad/Rawalpindi. Additional representatives are welcome to attend; however, their logistics costs will be borne by the respective organization.
