Muhammad Zubair, Ali Temoor and Muhammad Khurshid destroyed the whole structure of department and submitted the cases to MD (PPRA) for termination of services of following new appointed officers during probation period on the basis of forged/tempered documents of 37th BOD's Meeting Minutes showing delegation of powers in respect of termination of service of Employees.

- 1) Termination of services of Director General (HR) BS-20. (Ms. Saima Tasneem) without the approval appointing authority i.e PPRA Board.
- 2) Termination of services of Director General (IT) BS-20. (Muhammad Irfan Rafiq) without the approval appointing authority i.e PPRA Board.
- 3) Termination of services of **Director (HR) BS-19. (Dr. Saqib Yousaf)** without the approval appointing authority i.e PPRA Board.
- 4) Termination of services of Dr. Rahila Yousaf BS-18 without the approval appointing authority i.e PPRA Board.
- 5) Withdrawal of appointment letter of Muhammad Ali, Director (M & E) BS-19 without the approval appointing authority i.e PPRA Board.
- 6) Not allowed/accepted the joining of Mr. Ghous Bux Khari, Deputy Director (Legal) BS-18 SINDH Quota after issuance of appointment letter without the approval appointing authority i.e PPRA Board.

The sitting officers of PPRA have established certain lobby of Project staff, illegal appointed, promoted, upgraded officers / officials and created hostile environment for new appointees which cause termination of services of officers during probation period on the basis of forged/tempered documents of 37th Board Meeting held on 01.04.2019.

The Pakistan Information Commission (PIC) conducted an inquiry in the matter of delegation of powers to MD (PPRA) and vide order dated 13.01.2021 in Appeal No.455-08-2020 held that the officers of PPRA had been using tempered document (Minutes of 37th BOD's Meeting) to show that the PPRA officers could themselves terminate services of PPRA employees/officers. As per Para No.38 and 40 to 44 of (PIC) decision, it is established that the Minutes of PPRA 37th BOD's Meeting was tempered and MD/Officers of PPRA had been illegally exercising powers of the PPRA Board on the basis of forged documents showing delegation of powers in respect of appointment and termination of service. PIC vide letter dated 19-01-2021 forwarded the case to DG, FIA for initiation of proceedings under Section 22 (1) (d) (2) of the Right of Access to Information Act 2017.

The applicant joined Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) as Director (HR) on 1st June, 2018, after due competitive process such as advertisement, competitive exam, and recommendation from selection committee and with the approval of PPRA Board. Before joining PPRA, I had more than 15-Years of Professional Experience and Vast Experience in the field of HR including 14-Years in the Federal Govt, Departments. Furthermore, it is apprised that in addition to Master of Business Administration (MBA). I possess higher academic qualification in HR discipline i.e. PhD (Doctorate), from the world top ranked Business University of the World i.e. 'Vienna University of Economics and Business' Austria.
- 3. Mr. Fida Muhammad Wazir, the then MD (PPRA) retired from services on 17.04.2020, therefore the Post of MD (PPRA) remained vacant from 17.04.2020 to 23.07.2020 till the joining of new MD (PPRA) Mr. Rizwan Malik on 23.07.2020. - (7) That the ends of justice would be served if the reports on Petitioner application dated 20.08.2021 and Petition dated 09.12.2022 may please be requisitioned from Respondent No.1 being the Administrative Secretary and PAO of PPRA.

- 2. Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) is functioning under the administrative control of Cabinet Division. The Finance Secretary is the Chairman, PPRA Board. The PPRA Board (being appointing authority) selected the applicant through transparent selection process on the merit, as Director, Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) PPRA on 02.01.2018. Mr. Ali Temoor, Deputy Director (FIR) PPRA signed and issued the offer of appointment to the applicant vide offer letter dated 18-11-2019. The Applicant conveyed his acceptance against the said offer of appointment on 21-11-2019 and also submitted joining along-with attested copies of required documents vide letter dated 13.12.2019. The Applicant received another letter from PPRA dated 13-01-2020 with the subject Withdrawal of Offer of Appointment as Director (Monitoring & Evaluation" stating that the offer of appointment bearing No.3(4)/Admn/PPRA/2013 dated 18th November, 2019 is withdrawn and cancelled.
- 3. It is humbly stated that the impugned letter dated 13-01-2020 was issued without lawful authority with the approval of the then MD (PPRA) on the basis of bogus/forged/tempered documents of 37th BoD's Meeting held on 01.04.2019 showing delegation of Powers to MD (PPRA) on Para 11(b) to terminate the employees. (F/A) The reference of applicant's letter dated 20.12.2020 was given by Deputy Director (Mr. Ali Temoor) in his withdrawal letter dated 13.01.2020 by deliberately concealing Para No.1 of applicant's application dated 20.12.2020, record of acceptance applicant's letter dated 21-11-2019 and submission of documents vide letter dated 13-12-2019 in order to cause injury to the applicant within the meaning of section 167-PPC, which is an criminal offence. Cabinet Secretary also concluded the fact finding inquiry on the directions of Prime Minister of Pakistan issued vide letter dated 11.01.2022. (F/C).
- 4. The applicant's request seeking leave for joining till 30.01.2020 (vide applicant's letter dated 20-12-2019) was made an ISSUE by PPRA in its withdrawal letter which was not placed before the PPRA Board being appointing authority and withdrawal letter was issued with the intention to prove the lapse on the part of applicant, which is not the case in fact. Therefore, withdrawal letter dated 13.01.2020 was issued with the approval of in-competent authority (i.e MD (PPRA) which is a crime under section 167-PPC and withdrawal order does not qualify the test of fairness being issued with malafide intention and to deprive the applicant from joining PPRA. Moreover, the said letter was aimed at prejudice by concealing the facts submitted by the applicant through submission of acceptance of offer to PPRA within allowed time and causing injury by preparing fictitious ground for withdrawal.
- The Post of Director (M&E) is still vacant at PPRA and no lawful order for ignoring the Applicant has been passed by the competent authority (i.e. PPRA Board). Therefore, a fresh order allowing the applicant to join as Director (M&E)

- 6. It is further highlighted that the Pakistan Information Commission (PIC) vide its order dated 13.01.2021 in appeal No.455-08-2020 (F/B) held that the officers of PPRA had been using tempered document (Minutes of 37th BOD's Meeting) to show that the PPRA officers could themselves terminate services of PPRA Employees /Officers. In the light of Paras No.Para 5, 6, 10 11, 33, 38 & 40 to 44 of (PIC) decision, it is established that the Minutes of PPRA 37th BOD's Meeting were tempered and MD /officers of PPRA had been illegally exercising powers of the PPRA Board on the basis of forged documents showing delegation of Powers in respect of appointment and termination of service. The forged/tempered/Bogus Minutes (of 37th BoD's Meeting) comprise of 04-Pages while original minutes comprise of 03-Pages.
- 7. That the report of Pakistan Information Commission dated 13.01.2021 was time and again duly/officially conveyed to the Hon'able Members of PPRA Board by the affected persons whose services have been terminated under the guise of delegation of Powers, but even then, the Petitioner has moved application/representation dated 22.11.2021 to Chairman, PPRA Board and others Board Members, but no reply has been received from any quarters till date.
- 8. The applicant holds degrees like MA Development Studies (IISS of Erasmus University, Netherlands), M.Sc. Rural Development (Wye College University of London SDSC UOS link program), B.Sc. Honors (PMAS UAAR), LLB (BZU Multan), Diploma in Banking & Finance (Institute of Bankers Pakistan), PGD HRM, Management & PGD Criminology (AIOU, Islamabad), Project Management Professional (PMP®) Credential (PMI USA) and Certificates in Public Procurement (World Bank and LUMS). Moreover, the petitioner possesses more than Eighteen (18) Years of relevant Experience, which is a right mix of skill set to perform as Director (Monitoring & Evaluation) in (PPRA) in an exemplary manner.
- 9. In the light of findings of PIC Report dated 13.01.2021 (Annex-II), it has been established that the MD (PPRA) approved and issued the impugned letter dated 13.01.2020, without Lawful Authority on the basis of bogus/fake/tempered documents (Annex-I) of 37th BoD's Meeting held on 01.04.2019. Therefore, following prayers are submitted for issuance of directions to concerned quarters please.
 - i. Direct the Chairman, PPRA Board (Finance Secretary) to accept the applicant's joining letter dated <u>20.12.2019</u> and notify the joining forthwith.
 - ii. The applicant may be given chance for joining as Director (M&E) by considering his application for leave afresh.
 - iii. Set aside the Withdrawal of offer of appointment letter dated 13.01.2020 being issued without jurisdiction and of no legal affects as established in PIC report dated 13.01.2021.
 - iv. Direct the Cabinet Secretary, to submit the certified copy of Fact Finding Report as concluded on the directives of Prime Minister issued to Secretary Cabinet on 11.01.2022.

Any other favorable relief may also graciously be granted to the Applicant as may be deemed just and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

- 1. The Pakistan Information Commission (PIC) conducted an inquiry in the matter of delegation of powers to MD (PPRA) and vide order dated 13.01.2021 in Appeal No.455-08-2020 held that the officers of PPRA had been using tempered document (Minutes of 37th BOD's Meeting) to show that the PPRA officers could themselves terminate services of PPRA employees/officers. As per Para No.38 and 40 to 44 of (PIC) decision, it is established that the Minutes of PPRA 37th BOD's Meeting was tempered and PPRA Officers had been illegally exercising powers of the Board on the basis of forged documents showing delegation of powers.
- 2. Under Section 18 of the Ordinance provides that PPRA Board is the Authority to the appointment of officers, staff, advisors and consultants etc under section 18 (Appointment of officers and staff, etc). Regulation (13) and Regulation 2 (1) of (ESR-2017), described that appointing authority to various posts is the PPRA Board.
- 3. Under Section 16 of the General Clauses Act only the appointing authority has power to terminate the services of employee. Similarly, under Section 21 of the Act ibid, power to issue an order includes power to rescind, amend or modify that order. So, the authority who is competent to issue appointment order has inherent power to undo the appointment power. A lower authority cannot assume power of terminating the appointments made by the higher authority.
- 4. MD (PPRA) used the Power/Authority of PPRA Board on the basis of forged, tempered / bogus documents of 37th Board Meeting Minutes showing delegation of Powers to MD (PPRA) in respect of termination of service of Employees through addition of Para 11 (b) in 37th BoD's Meeting Minutes held on 01.04.2019, but the fact is that MD (PPRA) is not empowered to terminate, withdrawn the offer of appointment of Employees.
- 5. Managing Director, Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) abused his authority and used the Power of PPRA Board without any lawful authority and destroyed the whole structure of department and terminated the services, withdrawn the offer letters and repatriated the following new appointed officers illegally/unlawfully through illegal manner without the approval of appointing authority i.e. PPRA Board.

This Application is moved for 100% Compliance of Prime Minister's directives dated 22.06.2022 and Implementation of Recommendation of Cabinet Secretary/Inquiry Officer, who concluded the inquiry on the directions of Prime Minister Office issued on 11.01.2022. The Seven (07) Federal Secretaries (PPRA Board Members) used the Powers & Authority of President & Prime Minister of Pakistan and gave the indemnity through Non-recovery of Perks & Benefits w.e.f 01.06.2018 from the accused Muhammad Zubair and also provide protections to all his illegal acts, abuse of authority, Administrative/Moral Corruption/Corrupt Practices, fraud, assault/betray, harassment of Employees cases.

- 2. The Accused Muhammad Zubair never filed any Appeal/Application to President & Prime Minister of Pakistan for indemnity and no such type of evidences/documents are on the record. All Board Members willfully without any lawful authority gave the indemnity to the accused Muhammad Zubair and approved in 68th Meeting of BoD's held on 20.02.2023. This is a classic example of favoritism and abuse of authority by PPRA Board to extend favour to the culprit M. Zubair.
- 3. The Prime Minister office had issued directives vide letter dated 22.06.2022 that appointment of Muhammad Zubair in PPRA as DG (M&E) be declared void ab initio. Therefore, PPRA Board on 20.02.2023 in 68th Meeting passed decision as "The appointment of Mr. Muhammad Zubair in PPRA as DG (M&E) is hereby de-notified with immediate effect" without recovery of emoluments from 01.06.2018. The recommendations of Cabinet Secretary/IO and then issuance of Notification dated 21.02.2023 proves that M. Zubair, Ali Temoor, Muhammad Khurshid and Other 35-Employees were involved in administrative, financial and moral corruption as forwarded by 12-Nos Complaints by M/o Foreign Affairs (MoFA) on 08.12.2021.
- 4. The Seven (07) Board Members willfully totally ignored the following concealment of facts, frauds, Mis-representations and criminal offences of Muhammad Zubair, which he has done at the time of shortlistings on OTS Form and interview during the whole selection process till the date of his Joining in PPRA.

His B.Sc (Civil) Degree (Srl.No.867) dated 10.04.2001, Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) Certificate No.83864 dated 04.07.2003 and DMC (No. 270/13764) dated 17.03.2001 verify that he has completed all the requirements for the award of B.Sc Degree in Civil Engineering in March, 2001 i.e. 17.03.2001.
2.	False Statement/Fraud/Mis-representations/Concealment of Facts: On Page No.2 of OTS Form he mentioned Experience date from 30.10.2000, which is also a Big Proof of Fraud, Mis-representation and Concealment of facts.

Actual Facts: The fact is that his Post Qualification Experience starting date is 17.03.2001 from the date of attaining the required Qualification. The Experience shown by Muhammad Zubair from 30.10.2000 to 17.03.2001 cannot be considered as Post Qualification Experience, because he never possess the required qualifications upto 30.10.2000.

The FPSC Guidelines also define as "Post Qualification Experience" means the experience gained in a regular full time paid job including experience of daily wages/contingent services and that of the on job training subject to its relevancy acquired after attaining the requisite / minimum advertised qualifications.

Hence, in this way Muhammad Zubair Post Qualification Experience starting date is 17.03.2001 the date of attaining the required advertised qualification, which proves that he mentioned wrong date of 30.10.2000 on OTS Form to get shortlist.

3. False Statement/Fraud/Mis-representations/Concealment of Facts: He has submitted particulars in WP No.348 of 2018 on 30.01.2018, that he has passed his B.Sc (Civil) Engineering from UET Lahore in 2000 and mentioned experience starting from 30.10.2000.

<u>Actual Facts</u>: The fact is that his B.Sc (Civil) Degree, Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) Certificate and B.Sc DMC <u>verify that he has completed all the requirements for the award of B.Sc Degree in Civil Engineering in March, 2001.</u>

4. False Statement/Fraud/Mis-representations/Concealment of Facts: He has admitted on Para 6 of CM No.399 of 2019 dated 30.01.2019 in WP No.4708 of 2018, that he has passed his B.Sc (Civil) Engineering from UET Lahore in 2000.

Actual Facts: The fact is that his B.Sc (Civil) Degree, Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) Certificate and B.Sc DMC verify that he has completed all the requirements for the award of B.Sc Degree in Civil Engineering in March, 2001.

5. Managing Director (PPRA) uploaded the DMC (No.270/13764) of Muhammad Zubair on PM Portal in Complaint No.IS280519-2890496 dated 13.06.2019, wherein Result declaration of BSc (Civil) was written as May-1999 on the back side of DMC, which is also attested by Higher Education Commission (HEC) Officer vide ticket No.1565779 (Rs.800) dated 25.05.2018.

Muhammad Zubair has tempered the Original DMC No.270/13764 and mention false date of May-1999 by HAND Writing on the back side of DMC in order to cover the deficiency in Experience in reply of complaint on PM Portal.

Actual Facts: The fact is that his B.Sc (Civil) Degree, Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) Certificate and B.Sc DMC verify that he has completed all the requirements for the award of B.Sc Degree in Civil Engineering in March, 2001 i.e. 17.03.2001.

Muhammad Zubair was Registered in B.Sc (Civil) Engineering Programme in 1993 (93-Civil-575) in UET Lahore. He passed all Semesters Exams of his B.Sc (Civil) Engineering by 17.03.2001, which proves that he passed his B.Sc Degree (Civil Engineering) in Nine (09) Years. The fact is that the B.Sc (Civil) Engineering Degree Programme consisted of Four (04) Years in 1993 as per relevant rules and regulations. Therefore, it is required that to inquire from UET Lahore that under which Rules, Regulations & Policy in 1993, UET Lahore allowed the Muhammad Zubair to complete his Four (04) Years B.Sc Degree (Civil-Engineering) Programme in Nine (09) Years from 1993 to 17.03.2001 and involvement in any Suspension/Expelled from UET Lahore Case from during this Period. Further it is also require to inquire from Police Station Garree Shahoo & Police Station (UET) Campus Lahore and Inspector General Police (IGP) Punjab Office about the involvement of Muhammad Zubair in any Suspension/Expelled from UET Lahore Or any other Case during this Period.

- The Seven (7) (PPRA's Board Members) ignored the directives of the Prime Minister and also Secretary, Cabinet Division's recommendations and Partially Implemented the directives of superior Authorities. All Board Members favoured Muhammad Zubair without any lawful authority through illegal manner and involved in Abuse of Authority and favoritism. They Mishandled the case, willfully ignored the Prime Minister directives and recommendations, which is tantamount to Gross Misconduct of relevant Officers, those are involved in preparation of 68th Board Meeting Agenda Items and Proposals for Board approval. Therefore, it is required that to approve the Fact Finding Inquiry on relevant Agenda Item Points of 68th BoD's Meeting held on 20.02.2023.
 - a) Prime Minister issued directives on 22.06.2022 that appointment of Muhammad Zubair in PPRA as DG (M&E) is void ab initio, but PPRA Board Members willfully ignored this and never declared his appointment as Void ab initio and used the word de-notified with immediate effect, which established that Board Members consider his appointment as termination /removal from services with immediate effect instead of considering his appointment as void ab initio from the date of joining i.e. 01.06.2018. This is classic example of favouritism to give favour to accused Muhammad Zubair without any lawful authority.
 - b) The Inquiry Officer declared the appointment of Muhammad Zubair void ab initio, which means that Muhammad Zubair is an accused person and committed criminal offences for obtaining Job through illegal / deceitful Manner on 01.06.2018 and his appointment may be declared void ab initio and all Salaries/Perks and Benefits received may be recovered from 01.06.2018 to till date. The PPRA Board totally ignored this point and give favour to accused Muhammad Zubair without any lawful authority.
 - c) The Managing Director (PPRA) in notification dated 21.02.2023 indemnified all illegal actions of Muhammad Zubair i.e (1). Two Harassment Cases which are under trail. (2). Issuance of letters dated 14.08.2019 and 09.08.2019 without lawful authority. (3). Harassment/assault cases of PPRA Employees. (4). Recommendations of termination from services of PPRA officers. (5). Abuse of authority, corruption and corrupt practices, which is highlighted in NAB Islamabad Office in complaint dated 10.02.2020. (6). Preparation of Three Bogus/Fake Letters dated 26.08.2019, 16.11.2020 and 16.10.2017 with the connivance of Ali Temoor and Muhammad Khurshid after 1st July, 2019 and same submitted on different forums to take favour. (7). Tempering in 37th, 42nd and 41st PPRA Board Meeting Minutes. PPRA Board totally ignored these points and provided the protection on his all illegal acts.
 - d) The recommendations of Prime Minister, Cabinet Secretary and decision of PPRA Board in 68th Meeting established that Muhammad Zubair obtained the Job through deceitful manner by Fraud, Mis-representation and Concealment of Facts on the basis of forged, bogus & tempered documents, which is a criminal offence under section 35, 109, 200, 209, 419, 466, 468, 471 and 474 of PPC 1860. The PPRA Board Members willfully ignored these facts and never declared his appointment void ab initio from the date of his Joining i.e. 01.06.2018.

- e) Managing Director (PPRA) in notification dated 21.02.2023 also gave the indemnity that all emolument received by Muhammad Zubair during the course of his employment shall not be returned. The following points established/verified that PPRA Board had no authority to give the indemnity on fraud, Mis-representation, Concealment of facts, illegal acts, corruption/corrupt practices and criminal acts of accused Muhammad Zubair.
 - i. The recommendations of Secretary Cabinet Division verify that Muhammad Zuabir obtained the job through fraud and illegal manner, hence PPRA Board had no authority to legalize the Fraud, Mis-representation, Abuse of Authority, Concealment of facts and corruption and corrupt practices of Muhammad Zubair. The PPRA Board Members totally ignored these points on 20.02.2023.
 - ii. MD (PPRA) used the word indemnity in Notification dated 21.02.2023, which establish that Muhammad Zubair is the Culprit and committed criminal offence as stated on Para No.1 & 6 (e.) (i) above, therefore, it is required that to initiate the criminal proceedings u/s 35, 109, 200, 209, 419, 466, 468, 471 and 474 of PPC 1860 against the accused Muhammad Zubair forthwith.
 - iii. Muhammad Zubair Committed Criminal Offences, due to which he is not eligible to take indemnity from any forum. The Seven (07)

 PPRA Board Members have no Authority to give the indemnity to Mohammed Zubair in subject case.
- 7. The General Terms & Conditions mentioned on Serial No.12 of PPRA advertisement dated <u>14.10.2017</u> and <u>Muhammad Zubair's Undertaking on Serial No.4</u> of OTS Form empowers the PPRA Board being appointing authority to take the following actions in the light of above Facts and Grounds against the Muhammad Zubair & Muhammad Khurshid.
 - i. Direct the Finance Secretary/Chairman PPRA Board and all Members to declare the appointment of Muhammad Zubair void ab initio with the recovery of all emoluments from the date of his Joining i.e. 01.06.2018 and issue revised Notification for recovery forthwith.
 - ii. To issue the directions for fact finding inquiry on the facts/grounds of Proposal/Agenda item of 68th PPRA BoD's Meeting held on 20.02.2023, wherein PPRA de-notified Muhammad Zubair as DG (M&E) with immediate without recovery of all emoluments from 01.06.2018 alongwith indemnity on all his illegal acts.
 - Lahore that under which Rules, Regulations & Policy in 1993, UET allowed the Muhammad Zubair to complete his Four (04) Years B.Sc Degree Programme in Nine (09) Years from 1993 to 17.03.2001. Further, also inquire from Police Station Garree Shahoo & Police Station (UET) Campus and Inspector General Police (IGP) Punjab Lahore about the involvement of M. Zubair in any Case Or in any proceedings regarding expelled from UET Lahore etc etc from 1993 to 17.03.2001.

These bogus / fake letters prepared to protect Muhammad Zubair and Muhammad Khurshid from severe legal consequences, whom appointments were already challenged through WP Nos.2498 & No.2410 of 2019 on 27.06.2019 & 03.07.2019. 

In pursuance of the Prime Minister's Office U.O No. 2277/SPM/2021 dated 11th January, 2022 (Annex-I) this Fact-Finding Inquiry was conducted into the Allegations/Complaints leveled against Mr. Muhammad Zubair, DG(M&E) BS-20 officer of Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA), Islamabad by employees and ex-employees of the PPRA.

- Quality (SSE) (Annex-II) and subsequent request of M/o Foreign Affairs (Annex-III), the Establishment Division moved a Summary for appointment of Mr. Muhammad Zubair, DG (PPRA/BS-20) (hereinafter referred as the officer) as Deputy Secretary-General at ECO Secretariat, Tehran, Iran on 15-10-2021 (Annex-IV). However, the Hon'ble Prime Minister regretted the proposal due to the fact that the officer is not being a Civil Servant within the meaning of section 2(1) (b) of the Civil Servant Act, 1973, and therefore, not eligible for appointment against the subject position. The following directions were conveyed:
 - a). The Foreign Affairs Division shall clarify as to why before approval of the Prime minister i.e. the Competent Authority, Parep Tehran confirmed the nomination to ECO Secretariat?
 - b). Consideration serious complaints pending against the officer at different forums, the Cabinet Secretary, being Secretary of the Division concerned, shall order a fact-finding inquiry with regard to the conduct of the officer in accordance with relevant rules/regulations

- 4. Around 28 complaints against the officer were scrutinized and following allegations were framed for the purpose of fact finding inquiry:

The said officer is involved in illegal appointments, administrative corruption, the illegal firing of employees, forgery, non-compliance of IHC orders, misconduct, harassment, assault and also changing of minutes of the 37th PPRA Board meeting.

- 5. Detail of Documents/official records provided by the Establishment Division and other sources, relevant with the inquiry, were obtained and scrutinized (Annex-VI & Annex-VII).
- 6. The Managing Director (MD), PPRA was requested vide letter dated 15th February, 2022 to depute a well conversant officer to assist to provide relevant records the Fact Finding Committee. Mr. Farrukh Bashir DG(HR) was nominated as the focal person by the PPRA. Detail of Documents/official records obtained from PPRA is placed at Annex-VIII.
- 7. The accused officer, Mr Zubair DG(M&E), PPRA, was also given an opportunity of hearing vide letter dated 15th February, 2022 mentioned above (Annex-VIII). He also attended this office twice and was confronted with questions regarding allegations leveled against him in different complaints. He submitted his written reply vide letter dated 21st February, 2022 (Annex-IX). He mainly contented that the above-referred directives, issued by the Prime Minister's office, are without lawful authority and have been obtained by the Establishment Division without placing the true and complete picture of the case. He also emphasized that neither the Cabinet Division nor the PM office is

On the allegation, the PPRA responded that the services of Mr. Irian Rafiq DG (IT&R) and Ms. Saima Tasneem DG (HR) were terminated, by the then MD (PPRA), due to unsatisfactory performances during the initial period of probation while the services of (Ms. Rahila Yousuf) Ex-Deputy Director Research were terminated during the extended period of probation on 17-04-2020. (Annex-X)

Findings

As per PPRA's Regulations-2017, MD PPRA is the Competent Authority and has also been duly authorized by PPRA Board to extend, confirm the probation and terminate the services of the newly recruited employees of the Authority (Annex-XI). They have been removed by the competent authority as per law/rules/regulations. However, the complainants have filed different petitions in Islamabad High court and those are pending adjudications. As the matter is in the court, action may be taken on the basis of the outcome of the case.

A responded that incomplete draft minutes of the 37th Meeting of the Board, without one of the additional items titled "Probation of Employees" Authority, was inadvertently sent to the then Secretary Finance refirmen PPRA Board. Rather than approving the incomplete draft, the then cretary Finance/ Chairman PPRA Board recorded his observations on file regarding the incomplete draft and also personally called the then Managing Director in his office on 3rd April, 2019 to incorporate the same in the draft. Subsequently, the amended version was approved. However, a copy of unapproved minutes of 37th PPRA Board Meeting (bearing the initial signature of the MD PPRA) remained in the file due to the complacency of one of the officers who was proceeded against and awarded penalty of censure by the then MD PPRA. The Minutes of 37th Meeting of PPRA Board were also presented before the Honorable Islamabad High Court during the hearing proceedings of cases filed by Ex-DG (HR) and Ex-DG(IT). The Honorable Court vide judgment dated 30.06.2020, while dismissing the said cases, also referred to the relevant extracts of 37th and 39th PPRA Board Meetings, wherein the Agenda regarding the above-mentioned terminated probationary officers was ratified by the PPRA Board. It is worth mentioning that the Status of the Probation of PPRA Employees was again deliberated, as an Agenda Item No. 5 in the 39th Meeting of the PPRA Board held on 25.11.2019 with the title "Operational Issues of PPRA", in which referring the same agenda item f the 37th Board Meeting, PPRA Board ratified all the decisions of MD PPRA regarding appointment related issues. (Annex-XII)

Findings

As per available record, the then MD PPRA had admitted that a copy of unapproved minutes of the 37th PPRA Board Meeting (bearing the initial signature of the MD PPRA) remained in the file due to the complacency of one of the officers, who was accordingly awarded a penalty of censure by the then MD PPRA. (Annex-XIII). However, as the matter is being investigated by Federal Investigation Agency(FIA), therefore, the outcome of the inquiry may determine the future course of action on this issue.

Later on, a process of recruitment was initiated through the Open Testing Service (OTS) by conducting a written test of the eligible applicants after scrutiny of their applications. Results of written test for the posts of directors and Director generals were placed before the Selection Committee which took interviews of the top five shortlisted candidates for each post. Recommendations of the Selection Committee (Annex-XV) were presented before the PPRA Board in 34th Meeting held on 2nd January, 2018, wherein the Board decided to take final interviews of selected and alternate candidates against the posts of Director General(s) PPG-4/BS-20. The Board took the interviews of principal and alternate candidates for the posts of Director General(s) wherein the Board in its 35th meeting held on 4th January, approved the recommendations of the Selection/HR Committee for the appointment of Director General(s) in PPRA including Mr. Muhammad Zubair, DG M&E. Copy of the minutes of 34th and 35th are attached as (Annex-XVI).

Mr. Zubair had actual experience of 15 years and seven months which was five months short of the required experience (17 years). However, through a letter of Deputy Director(Admin) dated 16th October, 2017, additional practical experience of two (02) and four (04) years was allowed on the basis of higher qualification of MS/M.Phil. and Ph.D. degree.

the perusal of record and relevant regulations, it has been observed that per regulation 14 of PPRA Service Regulations, 2017 (Annex-XVII), the thod of appointment, qualifications, and experience of the incumbent to a metioned post and other conditions relating to various posts shall be as laid flown in Appendix-2 of the regulations, Para 2 (iv) (a) column 3 (Annex-XVIII) of the table clearly specifies that the candidate must possess a minimum of seventeen years post qualification relevant field experience. It is very obvious from his documents and record that Mr. Zubair did not possess 17 years of experience at the time of submission of the application. He completed his BSc Engineering in March, 2001. If we calculate his experience till the closing date of his application i.e. October, 2017, it comes to 16 years and 7 months. He was definitely short of 17 years by a period of almost five months (05). The deficiency of experience was compensated through a letter of DD Admn, wherein it was stated that any higher qualification i.e. MS/M.Phil. and Ph.D. would be given two years (02) and four (04) years as additional practical experience respectively. Mr. Zubair had MS Degree in Structural Engineering and was awarded two years of additional experience and he got qualified. The DD (Admn) misrepresented the facts and vide letter dated 16th October, 2017, he covered up the deficiency of requite experience by giving the double benefit for higher qualification.

Para 2 (iii) (b) of Appendix-2 (Annex-XIX) clearly states that a candidate who has obtained the degree of M.Phil. or Ph.D. during service shall not be entitled to a double benefit of counting the said period as service towards experience prescribed for the post. In this regard, General instructions issued by the Federal Public Service Commission (FPSC) were also examined, which also endorse the above-stated fact that a candidate who has obtained the degree of M.Phil./ Ph.D. during service shall not be entitled to a double benefit of counting the said period as service towards experience prescribed for the post (Annex-XX). Therefore his the appointment is void ab initio.

on, Mr. Zubair submitted an application (Annex-XXI) dated 29th May, 18, before MD PPRA for getting the double benefit on the basis of higher diffications and covering up the shortage of requisite experience after getting in offer letter from the PPRA. There is no approval of any relaxation granted to him by any forum.

Hence, the charge is proved as he does not have the requisite experience for the post for which he was considered and recruited.

The PPRA responded that the PPRA Board in 39th Meeting held on 25-11-2019, approved the creation of two senior-level posts i.e. Chief Software Specialist Principal Software Engineer funded under the project of e-Procurement. Minutes of the 39th Board meeting are attached (Annex-XXII). In the 41st Meeting of the PPRA Board, the agenda titled "status of two Posts for the e-procurement project" was presented before the PPRA Board wherein the Board approved the appointment of the Chief Software Specialist as per the remuneration fixed by the Managing Director (PPRA) in accordance with regulation 20 of PPRA Employees Service Regulations. The copy of the minutes of the 41st Meeting of the PPRA board is attached as (Annex-XXIII).

<u>Pindings</u>

The appointment of Mr. Tariq Javed Khan as Chief Software Specialist was done after the creation of said post by the PPRA Board. He was recruited after conducting the test by the testing agency, interviews of shortlisted candidates by the PPRA notified committee, and final approval of the PPRA board on the recommendation of the Selection Committee. Hence, it is not a charge against the officer.

e) Clarification sought by the NHA for Rule 26 Bid Validity:

PPRA evaluated the case after receiving a letter dated April 09, 2019, from NHA, and presented the same to the Managing Director (PPRA) for approval. Subsequently, the letter was issued on April 16, 2019. NHA raised some observations on the same matter through an email on April 30, 2019 (Annex-XXIV). The reply was sent on May 31, 2019, with the approval of DG (M&E) instead of MD PPRA.

b) Clarification sought by Directorate General Immigration and Passport regarding payment against partial delivery of cameras:

Initially, the matter was examined in the PPRA through Directorate General (Legal). Later on, under the direction of the MD (PPRA), the matter was evaluated by Mr Zubair, DG (M&E), and a letter was issued on February 13, 2019, with the approval of the then MD (PPRA).

c) Instructions regarding blacklisting/debarment of international organizations and determination of modalities to invoke clause 77.1 of the particular conditions of the contracts prescribed in PEC bidding documents:

The above mentioned instructions were directly issued by DG (M&E) under his signature vide letters dated August 09 and August 14, 2019 without examining and processing them on file for approval it is pertinent to mention that DG (M&E) was holding the additional charge of Managing Director during the said period.

Harassment, victimization, damaging credibility, and reputation of Rahila Yousuf ex-DD (Research)

Complements:-Dr. Rahila Yousuf ex-DD (Research) and Mr. Asim Bashir, DD (IT) PPRA.

PPRA submitted that Ms. Raheela Yousaf, the then DD (Research) launched a complaint of harassment against Mr. Muhammad Zubair before M.D PPRA on 25-10-2019 and also filed another complaint on the same matter on 25-11-2019 before Federal Ombudsman Secretariat for Protection against harassment (FOSPAH) of women at work Place, Islamabad. MD PPRA probed the matter and submitted his response vide Letter No. F.3(12) Admin/PPRA/2010 dated December 4, 2019, and F.No.3(12) Admin/PPRA/2010 dated December 31, 2019, to Federal Ombudsman Islamabad (Annex-XXV).

Findings

The matter is pending before Federal Generaleman Secretariat for Protection Against Harassment (FOSPAH) for went of decision. MD PPRA may be requested to pursue the case.

RECOMMENDATION(8) OF THE FACT FINDING COMMITTEE

Hence on the basis of the reply submitted by PPRA, findings, and grounds mentioned hereinabove, the following recommendations may be placed before competent authority after seeking approval of the Prime Minister:

1) National Accountability Bureau (NAM: Federal Ombudsman Secretariat for Protection Against Harassment at workplace (FCSPAH), and Federal Investigation Agency (FIA) may be approached to decide the matters expeditiously as mentioned at Para Number 8 (v, vi, and ii) respectively in above-stated report pending for want of decisions.

pointment of Mr. Zubair in Fr. A as DO(M&E) suffers from meeting requisite experience of almo nonths (C.) under PPRA Service regulations, 2017.PPRA Board appointing authority may be look into being void ab initio. MD PPRA should place the matter with the facts before the PPRA Board to decide the matter in accordance with the rules/law. Also, disciplinary proceedings, against Mr. All Tamoor then DD Admin, for misrepresenting the case before the Selection Committee and MD PPRA, be initiated for recommending and issuing a letter regarding the double benefit of experience to Mr. Zubair on the basis of higher qualification, which otherwise was not qualified.

3) During the conduct of inquiry and examination of the record, serious issues of lack of discipline, maintenance and movement of record/files without proper process (like without diary/dispatch), and litigant behavior of staff against each other including senior management, have been found in the PPRA. The Pract Board and the MD PPRA may be directed to take effective administrative measures to manage internal organizational issues.
