**Sub: Approval for meeting of OIG/USAID officials with MD PPRA**

TI Pakistan is implementing a project, the Anti-Fraud Hotline under an agreement with USAID for monitoring of US \$ 7.5 Billion USAID. At the signing of the project, TI Pakistan was able to convince USAID that all grants given under the Government to Government program should be implemented following PPRA rules for procurement instead of the USAID procurement rules.

During the course of the Anti-Fraud Hotline the OIG/USAID team has met with the MD PPRA a number of times to discuss matters of mutual interest. Some of their staff has also taken the training offered by PPRA.

Some officials of OIG/USAID are planning to come to Islamabad next week. They had desired to meet the MD PPRA on the 18<sup>th</sup> February, 2019. The office of MD PPRA has informed us that the approval of the Secretary, Cabinet Division is required for meeting with them. The OIG/USAID team wants to discuss how the PPRA rules are being followed by the G2G partners and the training of members of the OIG/USAID team.
