Sub: Complaint of Billions rupee Corruption in Health Department of Sindh

Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan has received complaint of Billions rupee Corruption in Health Department of Sindh.

The complainant has made following allegations;

1. That Misprocurement at a massive scale is being or has been perpetrated by the following political proxies and frontmen resulting in loss of billions of rupees to the national exchequer:
2. That M/s Allmed Solutions is owned by Ejaz Mirza's wife Address: A-21/3, KDA Scheme No.1 Extension, Stadium Road, Karachi. NTN No. 2975785-1, M/s Universal Enterprises is owned by Ejaz Mirza Address:29/3 Overseas Coop Housing Society Stadium Road Karachi NTN 0673179-1, M/s Ontech Corporation is owned by Ejaz Mirza's sister. Address:A-21/2, B-1, KDA Scheme -1 Extension, Stadium Road, Karachi. NTN No. 2295644-1, M/sNEOCON PVT LTD is owned by Ejaz Mirza's brother in law. Address: B2, Alshams Center Block 13 Gulshan e Iqbal Main University Road Karachi. Sales Tax Status suspended w.e.f. June 2013.
3. That these companies are operated through three companies in Dubai, M/s Masterlinks, M/S Phoenix Medicines Amnd M/S Allmed Llc.
4. That the fraudulent enterprise is run by Ejaz Mirza alongwith his brothers: Imran Mirza (who absconded to Uzbekistan for 10 years during 1990's action against terrorists and now resides in Islamabad, Mr. Aleem Mirza who recently bought a pharmaceutical company in Lahore manages Universal enterprises, and Mr. Abid Mirza who runs the Dubai companies. Their Dubai office and residences are regularly used by political leaders visiting Dubai.
5. Their offices in Karachi are frequented by MQM officebearers and Dr Waqar Kazmi, absconding principal of KMDC and chairman Khidmat e Khalq Committee MQM , and personal physician of Altaf Hussain used to regularly sit in their offices under Universal Research Group owned by Ejaz Mirza's wife.

Some of the glaring examples of this criminal nexus between Ejaz Mirza, Imran Mirza, Aleem Mirza, Abid Mirza, looting national resources are as follows:

- a. Purchase of 30 NIPRO Dialysis Machines @ US\$12985/ each by The Kidney Centre through Sindh Government by LC from ALLMED LLC



Dubai against a manufacturer's price of below US\$6000/- LC was opened by Universal Enterprises Karachi in favor of Allmed LLC Dubai at inflated rates whereas ALLMED LLC Dubai pocketed the differential and paid the manufacturer below US \$ 6000 per machine.

- b. Purchase of HIFU from non-ADP Scheme by Chandka Medical College Hospital for Rs 175,450,000 of a product that is not FDA approved for Radical Proctectomy even though required in the relevant PC-1. Moreover equipment which is FDA approved for these procedures from French source was purchase by SIUT for below Rs 50 million. The tender was deliberately manipulated to exclude French manufacturers and cartel made up of the above related companies participated to create the illusion of fair competition. These facts can also be verified from Prof. Adeeb ul Hassan Rizvi.
- c. Purchase of Urology Diode Laser by Chandka Medical College for Rs 16,280,000 which is about 10 times the manufacturer BIOLITEC Germany's price.
- d. Purchase of 8 units Shear Wave Elastography machines on non ADP scheme at Rs 25,600,000/ each total Rs. 204,800,000. Against a market price of Rs 6,000,000 to 7,000,000n for equipment with similar functionality. Also in this case Ontech and Neucon submitted dummy quotations so that Allmed may be awarded this tender. There are several instances where such cartelized bidding by these culprits has been observed and documented.
- e. Purchase of 2 units of DaVinci Robotic surgery Units supplied 2 units causing loss of Rs 600 million, to Qatar Hospital Karachi and Civil Hospital Karachi at around Rs. 420,000,000 each whereas the USA price of this equipment is below US\$1.0 million (Rs 100million) Dr Yousuf Sattar MS Qatar Hospital, with Dr Asim Hussains and Minister of Health are instrumental in awarding these contracts to Ejaz Mirza.

The DG NAB is requested to take up this compliant for inquiry, and if found correct for action under NAO 1999, Corruption & Corrupt practices, Section 9 (x).

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.

Robotic surgery: another view

I AM writing with serious disapproval and concern at the launch of da Vinci robotic surgery at the Sindh Government Qatar Hospital, Karachi. This is yet another prime example of how valuable and limited resources are mismanaged in our health care system.

Robotic surgery at this time is a luxury that we simply neither need nor can afford. When millions of people in Pakistan each year have no access to basic surgical care and hundreds of thousands die each year due to lack of surgeons and basic surgical facilities in the country, we must ask ourselves which avenues we should invest our money in?

We must appropriate our resources judiciously and not extravagantly. Where patients are not provided with essential medicines and they have to buy their own surgical sutures, where our public hospitals struggle to provide even clean bed sheets on hospital beds, how is this huge expense justified?

Robotic surgery has some benefit towards patient safety but what is its role in Pakistan? Its impact will be minimal and extremely cost-ineffective. We do not even have adequate hand-washing facilities in our surgical wards. There are numerous examples of low-cost and simple interventions that have an impact many times larger than

that of what robotic surgery offers. The poor people of Pakistan for whom this intervention is being projected to cater for are the ones who are going to suffer the most because of this impractical investment.

Millions of Pakistanis will continue to die or be disabled by the lack of surgical care and this robot is not going to make a grain bit of difference. It is not what the population of Pakistan needs and the government has to be blind or heavily influenced not to realise this.

Introduced in April 2014, the da Vinci Xi is the latest iteration of Intuitive Surgical's surgical robot. Compared to the da Vinci Si and Si-e, the Xi is better suited for multi-quadrant surgery because all 4 arms are mounted on an overhead boom, enabling repositioning without the need to undock the system. Also, the Xi arms are longer and slimmer than previous versions which may improve anatomical access.

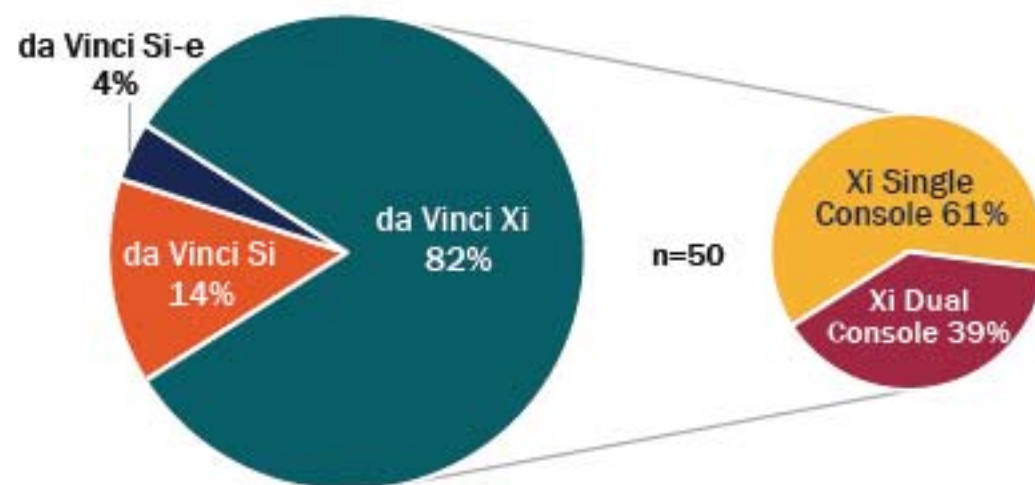

ECRI Institute Member Interest: da Vinci Robot Models

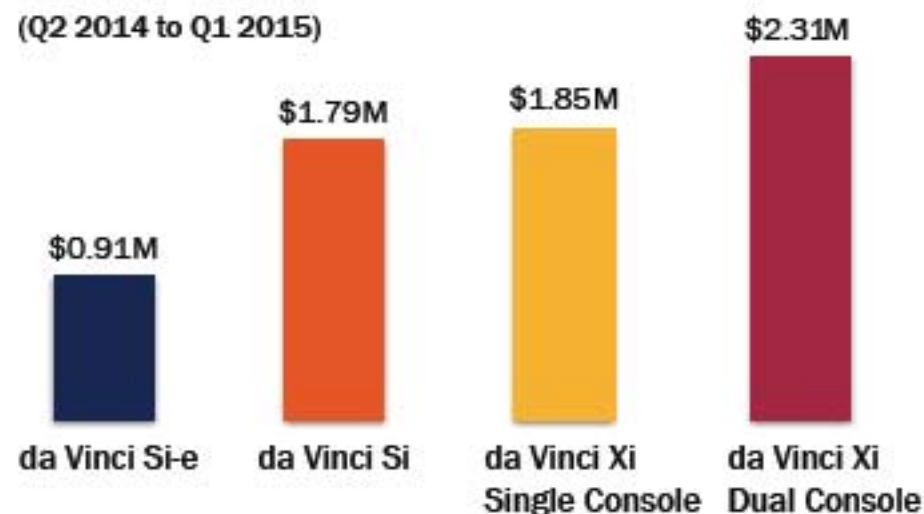
(Q2 2014 to Q1 2015)

Experts' reactions

Pakistan Medical Association Secretary General Dr Mirza Ali Azhar termed the budget a bit satisfactory in the current circumstance, but stressed that some reliable system of vigilance was needed to ensure that the allocated funds are spent accordingly.

Azhar said the current allocation was around 2.5 percent of the total budget, whereas according to the World Health Organisation's recommendations, it had to be 6 percent of the total budget.

He said the poor would get relief in the health sector only when the matters are taken care of on merit and the system is freed from corruption.

Citing a recent example of two public hospitals being equipped for robotic surgery, the PMA office-bearer said the equipment for a single hospital cost Rs390 million, whereas there is no concept of robotic surgery in Pakistan.

He said that in such cases, people with vested interests make money and the poor citizens continue to be helpless. Dr Azhar emphasised the government getting its priorities straight.

He said: "The government can prevent waterborne diseases by 90 percent if clean drinking water is supplied to the citizens. One can prevent being afflicted with a number of diseases, including gastroenteritis and hepatitis A, only by consuming clean water."

On the other hand, Dr Shershah Syed said that there was no need to increase the health budget if corruption was going to carry on unchecked.

Syed said 70 to 80 percent of the allocated budget is embezzled and the poor citizens cannot get any medicines from public hospitals.

He said that instead of increasing the budget, the government should have adopted measures to utilise the funds fairly.

In the current circumstances, increasing the health budget means increasing the ratio of corruption in the sector, he added.


