**Sub: Mis-Use of 'Authority' by Officers of the Government of Sindh in Various Housing Societies of Karachi.**

Dear Sir,

Transparency International Pakistan has received a complaint that the Cooperative Department, Government of Sindh has been manipulating allotment of illegal lands in about 67 Housing Societies of Karachi.


The complainant has made following allegations;

1. Under Section 43 the Cooperative Society Act, 1925, the department creates fake complaints against management of a society to the Registrar, and a false inquiry report is prepared against the management of that society. Then the Registrar orders to take over the society by dismissing the management, and appoints its own Secretary, Administrator and Registrar of the Housing Society. The Administrator is a private person, while the Secretary and Registrar are government officials.
2. The Secretary, and the Administrator in collusion, passes a resolution that 10% of plots can be allotted at the discretion of the management, by the Administrator.
3. Lucrative commercial as well as residential plots were then allotted in the names of front man of various political high-ups and bureaucrats.
4. All the above allotment are "Binami".
5. The scandal is going on since last 7 years, and property worth more than 100 Billion have been disposed of through this inventive conspiracy.
6. A front man of high political figure who is under arrest is responsible for these acts

Director General, NAB is requested to kindly examine the complaint, and if the allegations are found correct NAB may take steps to cancel all such illegal allotments, and also make accountable the corrupt public officials and the private persons involved in this heinous crime.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
