The National Accountability Bureau has constituted prevention committee for reforms in Ministry of National Health Services Regulations and Coordination (NHSR&C) for elimination of corruption and corrupt practices from the ministry.

The committee consists of DG A&P Division, NAB as president and members include from Pakistan Medical & Dental Council, National Institute of Health, Federal Government hospitals and other organizations. The mandate of the committee is to instruct and advise Ministry of National Health Services and attached offices to monitor the implementation of the instructions issued in order to achieve meritocracy, transparency, in all affairs and practices related to the NHSR&C.

The Committee will also educate and advise holders of public office in the Ministry of National Health Services Regulations & Coordination Division (NHSR&C) including different Divisions of DRAP, PMDC, NIH, Directorate of Malaria Control and other related public and private sector and community at large on measures to combat corruption and corrupt practices.


I am forwarding the TI Pakistan suggestions which will be helpful for the NAB Committee for Transparency, misuse of regulations and eradication of corruption in DRAP.

A complaint was received by TIP that vested quarters have approached to the recently appointed CEO of DRAP to roll back the Health & Enlistment Rules 2014 or to delay its implementation for unlimited time. A proposal was reported to be presented in Policy Board meeting.

TI Pakistan discussed this issue with Mr. Ayub Sheikh, Secretary Health., and he informed TIP that no such proposal is available on files.

Transparency International Pakistan is striving for across the board application of Rule of Law, which is the only way to stop corruption.
