The subject complaint was received at this Bureau on the allegation of exorbitant tariff rates claimed by PEDO for 40.80 MW KOTO Hydropower project located at District Dir Lower.

2. During the verification process, it is found that PEDO had filed tariff petition claiming exorbitant tariff rates which could adversely affect the consumers. However, the tariff has been approved by NEPRA at almost 50% reduced rates as NEPRA also found it on higher side.

3. Based on the findings, the case was considered at appropriate forum. The competent authority decided to refer the matter to your good office, for appropriate action to ensure inhibition of any such future occurrence (Copy of complaint is attached).
