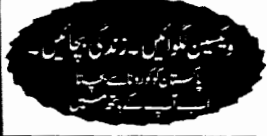

**PETITION FOR TARIFF MODIFICATION FILED BY CENTRAL POWER PURCHASING

HYDROPOWER COMPANY PVT. LTD. FOR 1,124 MW POWER PROJECT AT AZAD
JAMMU AND KASHMIR, PAKISTAN**

All stakeholders, interested/affected persons and the general public are notified that the Authority (NEPRA) has admitted the petition for tariff modification regarding 1,124 MW Kohala Hydropower Project located at Azad Jammu & Kashmir for consideration under Section 31 of NEPRA Tariff (Standards & Procedure) Rules, 1998, read with Rule 3 of NEPRA (Tariff Standards and Procedure) Rules, 1998.

SALIENT FEATURES OF TARIFF MODIFICATION PETITION

1. The project is located at Azad Jammu & Kashmir, Pakistan
2. The capacity of the plant is 1,124 MW
3. The determined levelized tariff of the plant is Rs. 8.2345/kWh at reference exchange rate of Rs. 104.85/US\$
4. The petitioner has requested the Authority to:
 - a) allow capital cost for construction of STPs of Rs 1,679 million
 - b) allow land cost of Rs. 62.87 million as estimated in the conceptual study
 - c) allow cost of construction of water bodies (WBs)
5. The Authority has decided to hold an online hearing on Tuesday, October 12, 2021, at 11:30 AM via Zoom which can be attended at <https://us02web.zoom.us/j/84216914314>, having meeting ID: 842 1691 4314
6. The following issues have been framed for the consideration of the Authority in the hearing:
 - i) Whether it is appropriate to modify the tariff after signing of IA and PPA?
 - ii) Whether the requested capital cost for Sewage Treatment Plants of Rs. 1,679 million is justified.
 - iii) Whether the requested cost of land of Rs. 62.87 million, estimated based on concept study, is justified.
 - iv) Whether it is justified to allow the requested provision for construction of Water Bodies at a later stage.
 - v) Any other issue with the approval of the Authority.
7. Any interested/affected person may participate in tariff setting proceedings through:
 - In terms of rules 6 & 7 of NEPRA (Tariff Standards & Procedure) Rules, 1998, any interested person who desires to participate in the proceedings may file an intervention request within seven (07) days from the date of publication of this notice. Such intervention request shall state the name and address of the person filing the same, objections and the manner in which such person is or is likely to be substantially and specifically affected by any determination in the proceedings. The intervention request may also contain the contentions of the person making the same, the relief sought and the evidence, if any, in support of the case.
 - Any person may also file the comments in the matter and the Authority, if deemed fit, may permit participation of such person into the proceedings and may also consider those comments in the final determination.
