TARIFF MODIFICATION PETITION FILED BY CENTRAL POWER PURCHASING AGENCY (CPPA-G) FOR THE EXCLUSION OF PRINCIPAL DEBT DAMAGES FROM STAR HYDROPOWER LTD. (SHPL) (147 MW PATRIND HYDROPOWER PROJECT) LOCATED AT DISTRICT MUZAFFARABAD, AZAD JAMMU & KASHMIR (AJ&K)

All stakeholders, interested/affected persons and the general public are notified that the Authority (NEPRA) has admitted the petition for tariff modification filed by CPPA-G regarding 147 MW Patrind Hydropower Project located at Muzaffarabad, Azad Jammu & Kashmir (AJ & K) for consideration under NEPRA (Import of Electric Power) Regulations, 2017 (IEPR-2017).

SALIENT FEATURES OF TARIFF MODIFICATION PETITION

- 1. The project is located at Muzaffarabad, AJ&K.
- 2. The net capacity of the plant is 147 MW.
- 3. The petitioner has requested the Authority to:
 - a) Allow modification in its tariff regarding revision in the Debt Service.
- The Authority has decided to hold an online hearing on March 28, 2023 at 10:30A.M via Zoom which can be attended at https://us02web.zoom.us/i/82612824386 having meeting ID: 82612824386.
- 5. Based on contents of the tariff modification petition, the following issues have been framed for the consideration of the Authority in the hearing:
 - i) Whether the revision of debt service as claimed by SHPL is justified or otherwise?
 - ii) Whether the London Court of International Arbitration's (LCIA) award is challenged by NTDC at any legal forum or otherwise?
 - iii) Any other issue deem appropriate by the Authority.
- Any interested/affected person may participate in proceedings of tariff setting process in the following manner:
 - In terms of rules 6 & 7 of NEPRA (Tariff Standards & Procedure) Rules, 1998, any interested person who desires to participate in the proceedings may file an intervention request within seven (07) days from the date of publication of this notice. Such intervention request shall state the name and address of the person filing the same, objections and the manner in which such person is or is likely to be substantially and specifically affected by any determination in the proceedings. The intervention request may also contain the contentions of the person making the same, the relief sought and the evidence, if any, in support of the case.
 - Any person may also file the comments in the matter and the Authority, if deemed fit, may permit participation of such person into the proceedings and may also consider those comments in the final determination.
